DESCRIPTION OF LAND

All interests except interests already owned by the acquiring authority in 2517 square metres of land comprising:

- (a) A strip of land 4 metres wide extending 120 metres to the west of the footpath leading south from Badshot Farm and 411 metres to the east of the said footpath through rough grass, scrub and pasture land to the north of the dismantled railway formerly leading from Farnham to Guildford via Tongham, and to the south of Badshot Farm and Watership Farm, Badshot Lea.
- (b) 33 square metres rough grass to the north-east of Watership Farm and,
- (c) 357 square metres pasture land to the north-east of Watership Farm.
