

Magistrates' Court sitting at Castle Street, Sheffield, on 29th July 1991 at 10 a.m. for an Order under section 116 of the Highways Act 1980, that the highway known as Lockhouse Road, extending from its junction with Attercliffe Common for 60 metres in a south-easterly direction and thence for 115 metres in a general easterly direction to its termination be authorised to be stopped-up on the ground that it is unnecessary.

The effect of the Order is shown on the plan which may be inspected, free of charge, at my office at the Town Hall, Pinstone

On the hearing of the application any person who is interested in land abutting on or served by the said highway or uses the said highway or is otherwise aggrieved shall have a right to be heard.
