ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Devon (Town Centre, Cullompton) (Prohibition of Waiting and Parking Places) Order 1991*

Notice is hereby given that in conjunction with the Town Centre Enhancement Scheme, Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1)-(3), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. When the proposed Order comes into effect:

1. You will not be permitted to leave your vehicle at any time in the following lengths of the High Street:

*East side*

- from its junction with Tiverton Road to a point 29.5 metres south of its junction with St. Andrews Road.
- from a point 15.5 metres south of its junction with St. Andrews Road to a point 10.5 metres north of that junction.
- from a point 15 metres north of its junction with St. Andrews Road to a point 17.5 metres north of that junction.
- from a point 29.5 metres north of its junction with St. Andrews Road to a point 31 metres north of that junction.
- from a point 43 metres north of its junction with St. Andrews Road to a point 44 metres north of that junction.
- from intersection of north side of Higher Mill Lane with High Street to its junction with Station Road.

*West side*

- from its junction with Tiverton Road to a point 47.5 metres north of that junction.
- from a point 55 metres north of its junction with Tiverton Road to a point 29 metres south of its junction with St. Andrews Road.
- from a point 17 metres south of its junction with St. Andrews Road to a point 12 metres north of that junction.
- from a point 34 metres north of its junction with St. Andrews Road to its junction with Station Road.

There will be an exemption to the above to provide a Taxi Rank and Bus Stop and Layover points.

2. Parking Places at right angles to the kerb will be provided in High Street as follows:

*Part East side*

Limited Waiting (22 spaces)—1 hour (no return within 1 hour) 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday

*Part West side*

- (a) Unrestricted Waiting (6 spaces)
- (b) Orange Badge Holders (5 spaces)—2 hours (no return within 2 hours) 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday
- (c) Loading Bay (1 space)
- (d) Veterinary Surgeons (2 spaces)
- (e) Doctors (3 spaces)
