Notice of application for consent in pursuance of Schedule 12

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 12 of the Water Act 1989, that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority—Anglian Region by Anglian Water Services Ltd. for consent to discharge. The maximum volume of fully treated sewage effluent being discharged from Helmdon Sewage Treatment Works will increase from 382 to 709 cubic metres per day and the maximum volume of settled storm sewage from 611 to 654 cubic metres per day. The increase in volume is due to growth in the area and the transfer of flows from Sulgrave Sewage Treatment Works, which is to close. The discharges will be from National Grid Reference point SP 5843 4377 into the Helmdon Brook (tributary of the River Tove) within the South Northamptonshire District Council area from Helmdon Sewage Treatment Works, Helmdon, Northamptonshire.

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 12 of the Water Act 1989, that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority, Anglian Region, by Anglian Water Services Ltd. for consent to discharge from the new Brackley sewage treatment works which will replace the existing sewage treatment works. The maximum volume of fully treated sewage effluent being discharge will increase from 8,725 to 12,853 cubic metres per day and a discharge of up to 7,019 cubic metres per day of settled storm sewage may be made. The discharges will be from National Grid Reference point SP 6002 3584 into the River Great Ouse on the border of the
