

LAUNCESTON TOWN COUNCIL

The Launceston Town Council (Off-street Parking Places Amendment (No. 3)) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that on 15th July 1991 the Launceston Town Council made the above Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to control the use of the parking place named in the Schedule to this notice which shows the class of vehicles, the period of operation, the charging hours, the maximum period for waiting and the scale of charges and to set a penalty for unauthorised parking at £25.

The Order will come into operation on 22nd July 1991.

A copy of the Order as made and copies of the relevant map may be inspected at the Council Offices, The Town Hall, Launceston, from Monday to Friday between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 1 p.m.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any Regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application to the High Court for that purpose.
