North Bedfordshire Borough Council (Various Roads, Bedford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Consolidation Order 1982, Amendment No. 48).

— from a point 31 metres west of its junction with Brendon Avenue eastwards for a distance of 97 metres to a point 66 metres east of said junction.

- from a point 125 metres west of its junction with Haylands Way eastwards for a distance of 367 metres to a point 242 metres east of said junction.

from a point 31 metres north of its junction with Dawlish
Drive southwards for a distance of 90 metres to a point 59 metres south of said junction.

(ii) on the south/west side

- from a point 213 metres west of its junction with Barnstaple Road southwards for a distance of 354 metres to a point 141 metres south of said junction.
