The County of Dorset (Various Roads, Stinsford) (Heavy Commercail Vehicle and Coach Restriction) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Dorset County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to:

- Revoke that part of the County of Dorset (Various Roads) (Weight Restriction) Order 1975 in so far as it relates to lengths of road at Stinsford (in Articles 1 and 2) of the Schedule.
- 2. Prohibit heavy commercial vehicles (over 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight) and coaches, except for loading, on the following lengths of road:
  - (a) the road to Stinsford Church from its junction with the Dorchester to Tincleton Road (C80) to its termination at St. Michael's Church, Stinsford.
  - (b) Cuckoo Lane and Bockhampton Lane, Stinsford from its junction with the Dorchester to Puddletown Road (A35(T)) to its junction with the Dorchester to Tincleton Road (C80).
  - (c) Bockhampton Lane, Stinsford and West Stafford from its junction with the Dorchester to Tincleton Road (C80) to its junction with the Dorchester to West Stafford Road (C33).

Exemptions will permit vehicles to proceed in the lengths of road referred to for the purposes of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, post office vehicles delivering or collecting mail, emergency service vehicles, vehicles in connection with any building or demolition operation, the maintenance of the road, the collection of household refuse, the supply of gas, water or electricity, work to any telegraphic line, agricultural purposes, and vehicles with a need to be garaged, serviced or repaired at any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of road referred to in the Order
