RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND

NOTICE

The Treasury in pursuance of section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 (as amended) hereby give notice that on or after 31st July 1991:

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1989

The Trunk Road (A55) (Halkyn, Clwyd) (Prohibitions of 'U' Turns and Closure of Central Reservation Crossings) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales, proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984. The effect of the proposed Order will be to:

- i. close the gaps in the central reserve in that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 95 metres north-west of its junction with Coed-y-Cra Road in a general north-westerly direction to a point 160 metres south-east of the centre line of the underbridge at the Pentre Halkyn Interchange (B5123); and

- ii. prohibit any vehicle proceeding in the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at Halkyn to make a U-turn:
 - a. at the central reservation opening opposite the junction of the trunk road with Caeau Gleision Lane; or
 - b. at the central reservation opening opposite the junction of the trunk road with Coed-y-Cra Road; and
- iii. revoke the Trunk Road (A55) (Halkyn, Clwyd) (Temporary Prohibition of 'U' Turns and Temporary Closure of Central Reserve Crossings) Order 1989.

A copy of the proposed Order, a copy of the Order being revoked, together with a plan and statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of Delyn Borough Council, Civic Offices, Coleshill Street, Holywell, Clwyd CH8 7LX.

Objections specifying the grounds on which they are made, quoting reference ZC 510-1-1-30, must be sent in writing to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, by 23rd August 1991. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
