HUMBER POWER LIMITED

Notice of an application for consent to construct a combined cycle gas turbine power plant at South Humber Bank

Notice is hereby given that Humber Power Limited ('the Company') has applied under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 ('the Act') for the consent of the Secretary of State for Energy to construct and operate a Combined Cycle Gas Turbine Power Plant at South Humber Bank, and for a direction under section 90(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 that planning permission for the development be deemed to be granted.

The new station to be known as Humber Power Plant would have a capacity of approximately 1,100 megawatts (MW) consisting of three modules, each of approximately 366 MW.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

County of Avon (Patchway) (District of Northavon) (Doctor Parking Places) Order 1991

BARNESLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley (Penistone, Cawthorne, Millhouse Green and Silkstone Common) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 1987 (Amendment No.) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit any vehicle, with the exception of agricultural vehicles, from proceeding in that length of Leapings Lane at Thurlstone which extends from a point 117 metres south-east of its junction with Manchester Road (A628) in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 51 metres.
