SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*New Traffic Proposals for the County of South Glamorgan*

Notice is hereby given that the county of South Glamorgan, in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intends imposing traffic restrictions on the lengths of road referred to in Column 1 of the Schedule below.

The nature of the restriction is shown in Column 2 of the Schedule and the titles of the proposed Orders are shown in Column 3.

Exemptions to the restrictions marked with an asterisk (\*) will be permitted for boarding and alighting from a vehicle; loading and unloading of goods, essential services and funerals, for a maximum of two hours, vehicles when displaying an Orange Badge and being used for the conveyance of disabled persons.

Full details of the proposals and plans showing the location and extent of the proposed restrictions may be seen at the address shown below during normal office hours, or at the Vale of Glamorgan Borough Council, Holton Road, Barry, for that Order affecting the Barry Area, or a Penarth Branch Library for the Order affecting the Penarth area.

Any objection you may have to any of the proposals must be submitted to me in writing by 23rd August 1991, and must contain the grounds on which you object. Any such objection may be made available for inspection by any interested parties in accordance with the Local Government Access to Information Act 1986.
