NEW TOWNS ACT 1981

The New Town of Milton Keynes extinguishment of public right of way over footpath No. 4 (Milton Keynes)

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public right of way over the following route shown as a thick red line on the map numbered IED/1329 referred to herein:

That length of footpath No. 4 in the parish of Milton Keynes, from a point marked 'A' on the map approximately 70 metres south-west of the junction of Broughton Road and Walton Road in Milton Keynes Village and running in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 950 metres to a point marked 'B' on the map approximately 480 metres north-west of the V10/H8 roundabout.

A map showing the right of way proposed to be extinguished may be inspected at the offices of the Milton Keynes Development Corporation, Saxon Court, 502 Avebury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes MK9 3HS, during normal office hours. Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing clearly stating all the grounds of the objection and addressed to the Secretary of State for the Environment (Ref. TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990
