(i) between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week in the length of street referred to in sub-paragraph (a)(i) above;

(ii) between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of street referred to in sub-paragraph (a)(ii) above;

(c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle in the lengths of streets referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Enfield Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the street and lengths of streets referred to in subparagraph (a) above will be prohibited.

(e) the hours during which the existing prohibition applies on:
(i) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle)
