PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

Notice of the issue of a submarine pipe-line works authorisation

The Secretary of State for Energy hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to E E Caledonia Limited, whose address is 123 Buckingham Palace Road, London SW1W 9SW, for the construction of a 6 inch pipe-line, a 3 inch pipe-line and a chemical injection umbilical between Piper 'B' Platform and the Chanter Wellhead Protection Unit.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the 6 inch pipe-line shall only be used to convey oil/condensate, the 3 inch pipe-line shall only be used to convey lift gas and the chemical injection umbilical shall only be used to convey start-up gas, methanol and corrosion inhibitors.

The pipe-lines may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.
