The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to ordain and declare that Edward Renfric Arundell, Major in Her Majesty's Army (retired) shall henceforth have, hold and enjoy the same title, rank, place, pre-eminence and precedence as the son of a Baron which would have been due to him had his father Reginald John Arthur Arundell (formerly Talbot) survived his Kinsman Joseph Hubert George Baron Talbot of Malahide and thereby succeeded to the title and dignity of Baron Talbot of Malahide.

And to command that the said Royal Concession and Declaration be recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms. (41 SI)
