

(h) I have obtained from the owner of this horse or his agent a written declaration stating that the horse will be conveyed direct from its premises of origin to the country of destination without coming into contact with horses not similarly certified, in a vehicle previously cleaned and disinfected with a disinfectant officially approved in this country.

This certificate is valid for 10 days from the date of signature.

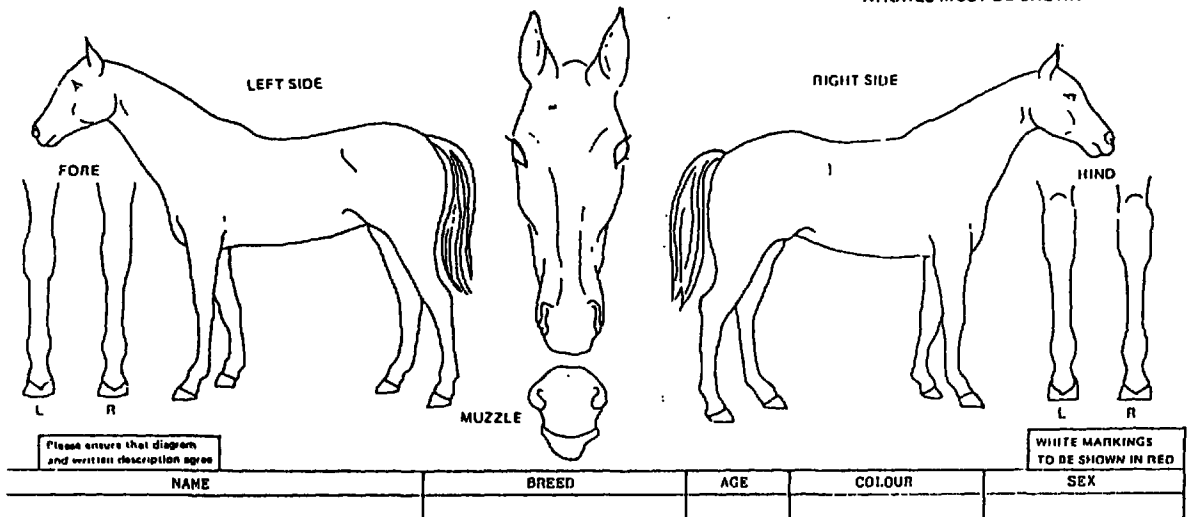

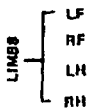
**NOTES**

**ANIMAL HEALTH ACT 1981**

**THE IMPORTATION OF EQUINE ANIMALS ORDER 1979**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food by this licence issued under Article 4 of the Importation of Equine Animals Order 1979, hereby authorises, in accordance with the conditions set out below, the landing of Equidae from Belgium, Denmark, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands and Greece at any port/airport in England with Customs and Excise facilities, until further notice or unless revoked by the Minister.

This licence comes into force with effect from 1st January 1992.
