Stopping-up of a Highway at Manchester

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Proposed Stopping-up of Highways at Manchester

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of the Manchester City Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 248 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and section 125 of the Highways Act 1980 to authorise the stopping-up of various highways at Manchester all on or in the vicinity of the route of the proposed Manchester Intermediate Ring Road Stage 2, in the interests of safety of users of and to facilitate the movement of traffic on the Manchester Intermediate Ring Road Stage 2, which is to be constructed along a route linking Grey Mare Lane at its junction with Ashton Old Road to Mill Street, Beswick and extending in a northerly direction along improved lengths of Pottery Lane, Mill Street and Hulme Hall Lane to its junction with Oldham Road, Miles Platting in accordance with planning permission granted by Manchester City Council under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

The proposed Order will require the provision of new highways maintainable at the public expense for which the highway authority is to be the Manchester City Council, and the improvement of existing highways.
