ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BOURNEMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Bournemouth (Bath Road/Upper Hinton Road) (Prohibition of Right Turn) (Experimental) Order 1992

The Borough of Bournemouth (Russell-Cotes Road/Bath Road) (Obligatory Left Turn) (Experimental) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that the Bournemouth Borough Council, acting as agent of the Dorset County Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the said County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2) and 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, has made the above Order.

The Order is operative from 10th February 1992, and from then the provisions in the Schedule to this notice will apply.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the prohibited/restricted areas are available at my office where they may be examined between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, as amended, or of any Instruments made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 30th January 1992, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Bournemouth Borough Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently varied by another Order under section 9 of the Act or modified pursuant to sub-section (2) of section 10 of the Act, from the coming into operation of that variation or modification (whichever is the latest), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite confirmation. Such objection must be in writing, must give the grounds on which it is made and must be made to the address shown below.

All traffic in Bath Road is prohibited from making a right turn into Upper Hinton Road.

All traffic in Russell-Cotes Road must make an obligatory left turn on entering Bath Road. (768)

CLWYD COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Clwyd (Queens Road and Groes Lwyd, Abergele) (Prohibition of Waiting and One-way Traffic) Order 1992.

Notice is hereby given that the Clwyd County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

- To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the length of roads or on the sides of lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.
- (2) To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the lengths of road other than that specified in column I of Schedule 2 to this Order in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of the said

Exceptions will be provided in the proposed Order to permit waiting for the purposes of alighting, boarding, loading, unloading and works of maintenance, repair and the like.

Exceptions will also be provided in the proposed Order to allow vehicles displaying both a disabled person's badge and a disabled person's parking disc to wait in the length of road and on the sides of lengths of road specified in the said Schedule for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour for a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same day).

Vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for an unlimited period of time on the side of length of road specified in the said Schedule.

The County of Clwyd (Various Streets, Abergele) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1980 will be amended as necessary.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the side of length of road to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Shire Hall, Mold, during normal office hours.
