TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Proposed Stopping-up of Highways at Manchester

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Downs and Variava on behalf of Manchester University he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of a length of an unnamed road servicing the rear of properties on Grafton Street, Manchester and a footpath which runs from the south western end of the unnamed road to Grafton Street to enable residential development consisting of the erection of flats and retail units to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Manchester University.
