*The Camden (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Order 199**

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to:

(a) amend the hours of operation of waiting and loading restrictions specified in the Schedules to this Notice, so that;

(i) for those streets or parts of streets specified in Schedule 1 of this Notice the hours of operation of the waiting restrictions will be amended to become 8.30 a.m. and 8.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

(ii) for those streets or parts of streets specified in Schedule 2 of this Notice the hours of operation of the waiting restrictions will be amended to become 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

(iii) for the area of High Holborn specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice the hours of operation of loading restrictions will be amended to as specified in that Schedule.

(iv) for those streets or parts of streets specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice the hours of operation of waiting restrictions will be amended as specified in that Schedule.

A copy of the Order, of the Camden (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976, and of the Orders which have previously amended or applied that Order, and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Planning Enquiries Section, Fifth Floor, Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street Entrance, London WC1H 8EQ, within 21 days of the date on which this Notice is published.
