- (a) between 7 a.m. and midnight throughout the week on the area of carriageway lying within or adjacent to the length of Hertford Road, specified in Schedule 1 to this notice and which area is marked on the carriageway thereof by a yellow "bus stop" marking and by double yellow lines within that marking;
