

1. An Order under sections 10, 106 and 108 of the Highways Act 1980 which will:
 - (1) provide that a road which he proposes to construct along the following route shall become a trunk road from the date when the Order comes into force, namely a route about 170 metres in length, from the new A500 southbound exit slip road to the new A50 eastbound entry slip road at the new roundabout at Sideway in the City of Stoke-on-Trent in the County of Staffordshire (the new roundabout and slip roads being highways which the Secretary of State proposes to construct, referred to in article 1 of the (A50) Nottingham-Derby-Stoke-on-Trent Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge to Queensway and Connecting Roads) Order 1992); and
 - (2) authorise him to construct as part of the road on that route a bridge over the navigable waters of the Trent and Mersey Canal, and to divert part of the towing path of that Canal in connection with the construction of that bridge.
2. An Order under sections 14, 106, 108 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the new Trunk Road described at 1(1) above which will:
 - (1) authorise him to:
 - (a) construct a new highway,
 - (b) stop-up private means of access to premises,
 - (c) provide new means of access to premises,
 - (d) construct a bridge over the navigable waters of the Trent and Mersey Canal, and
 - (e) divert that Canal,
 all at Sideway in the City of Stoke-on-Trent; and
 - (2) provide for the transfer of the new highway to the Staffordshire County Council as highway authority from the date on which he notifies them that it has been completed and is open for traffic.

Any person aggrieved by an Order mentioned in this notice who desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provision in it, on the ground that:

- (a) it is not in the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or
- (b) any requirement of that Act or of regulations made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to that Order.

may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice. On such an application, the Court may suspend or quash that Order or any provision in it.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. An Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the A13 Trunk Road at South Bromley in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets which will authorise him to improve highways and to stop-up a length of highway all in the vicinity of the route of the trunk road mentioned above.
2. An Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, in relation to the A13 Trunk Road at South Bromley in the

London Borough of Tower Hamlets which will authorise him to:

- (a) improve highways,
- (b) stop-up highways,
- (c) stop-up private means of access to premises, and
- (d) provide a new means of access to premises,

all in the vicinity of the route of the trunk road mentioned above.
