Birmingham City Council (Alum Rock Road, Etc. Alum Rock) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Variation) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be as follows:

To correct an anomaly in the 1988 Traffic Regulation Orders governing the prohibition and restriction of waiting in Bowyer Road, Alum Rock. The carriageway markings have always construed the true intention of the Order but there is an error in the lengths of road included in the Schedules to the Orders. To correct these anomalies and provided there are no objections to the proposals and for greater clarity it is proposed to revoke the 1988 Orders and reintroduce their provisions with the incorrect dimensions amended.
