## Bubiffied by Authority.

From Tuesday March 8. to

Bruffels. March 18. Geldermalien coming hither the 12th Inflant ar Night, had a Conference the next Day with Count Koningfeck, and immediately after disparched a Courier to the States General, for their Orders to concert with that Minister the quartering and Sublifting of the Imperial Troops which are coming into thef Provinces: Last Night an Express from the Hague brought a Resolution of their High Mightinesses to M. Geldermalfen and Vandenberg, relating to the Difpeti-tion of the faid Troops into divers Places of Braban and Flanders; upo which those Ministers had a Conference with Count Koningfeck, and fent the Courier back to the Hague with an Account thereof. The Count has fent Order to the Imperialifts, not to advance beyond Louvain till they receive further Directions from him This Evening an Express arrived here, with Letters from Vienna of the 10th of this Month, by which we learn that Mr. Cadogan having received the Emperor's An fwer, and finished his Negotiation at that Court, intended to set out towards Holland the 14th.

London, March 9. This Day the Heers Van Duven-voirde and Van Boriele, Ambaffadors extraordinary from their High and Mightinesses the States General of the United Provinces, made their Publick Entry. They were received at Greenwich by the Earl of Tankerville. and Sir Clement Cottrel Mafter of the Ceremonies, accompanied by Six Gentlemen of his Majesty's Privy Chamber. Fr. m thence they were brought by Water, together with all their Train in his Majesty's Barges to the Tower: At their landing they were received by Robert D'Oyly, Eiq; Deputy to the Lieutenant of the Tower, in the Absence of the Earl of Northampton Constable of the faid Tower and the Guard being drawn our upon the Wharf faluted their Excellencies as they passed by. The Royal Standard was display'd upon this Occasion. Their Excellencies dispens'd with the firing of the Guns, least much Mischiet might have ensued to the Custom-house and many other Houses near adjoining, extreamly shatter'd by the late dreadful Fire. From thence they proceeded to Somerset House in the following Manner. The Earl of Tankerville's Coach, thirty two of the Ambassa dors Footmen walking two and two, eight Pages, and the Gentleman of the Horfe mounted on Horfe-back; then came the King's Coach of State, in which were the Ambaffadors, the Earl of Tankerville and the Mafter of the Ceremonies; this was followed by another of the King's Coaches, as was that by one of his Royal Highnef' the Prince of Wales, in these came the Six Gentlemen of the Privy Chamber; afterwards came five of their Excellencies Coaches drawn by eight Horses each, which were follow'd by a numerous Train of Coaches of the Nobility and Gentry, with fix Horses each. When they arriv'd at Somerset House, the Place appointed by his Majesty for their Entertainment, the Earl of Tankerville put them into Possession of the House, and took his Leave; soon after came the Lord Harborough with his Majefly's Compliment of Welcome to the Ambassaders, as did the Lord Finch Gentleman of the Bedchamber to his Royal Highness, in waiting; and Mr. Pulteney Vice-Chamberlain to her Royal Highness; both sent by their Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess of Wales upon the same Occasion.
