Essex County Council (Various Streets, Stansted Mountfitchet) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that on 12th November 1992 the Essex County Council made the above Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
