The Diversion of Highways (County of Norfolk) No. 1 Order 19

The A50 Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge to Queensway and Connecting Roads) (No. 2) Order 199

The A50 Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge to Queensway and Connecting Roads) (Side Roads) (No. 5) Order 199
