LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE ACT 1988

The Wimbledon and Putney Commons (Special Levies) (Amendment) Regulations

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment proposes to make the above-mentioned Regulations under sections 75, 118 and 143(1) and (2) of the Local Government Finance Act 1988.

The Regulations would amend the Wimbledon and Putney Commons (Special Levies) Regulations 1990, which provide for the financing of the upkeep of the Wimbledon and Putney Commons by the Wimbledon and Putney Commons Conservators.

The Regulations are required following the introduction (with effect from 1st April 1993) of the Council Tax under the Local Government Finance Act 1992.

The Regulations would provide:

- for the London Boroughs of Kingston, Merton and Wandsworth, to whom the Conservators issue special levies to cover their expenditure on the Commons, to recover the amounts through the council tax, relating to the parts of their areas falling within the levying area;
- for the total amount of the levies for any year (from 1st April 1993) to be apportioned between the three Boroughs according to the council tax base of the parts of their areas affected;
- for other consequential and supplementary matters.
