In The High Court of Justice (Queen's Bench Division)

In The High Court of Justice (Queen's Bench Division) Divisional Court before the right honourable Lord Justice Rose and the honourable Mr. Justice Pill in the Matter of section 42 of the Supreme Court Act 1981 (as amended by section 24 of the Prosecution of Offences Act 1985) between Her Majesty's Attorney General Applicant and Arthur Robinson and Frieda Alberta Robinson Respondents.

Upon reading the Originating Motion herein dated 21st September 1990 issued by the Applicant Her Majesty's Attorney General seeking a civil proceedings order against the above-named Respondents pursuant to section 42 of the Supreme Court Act 1981 (as amended by section 24 of the Prosecution of Offences Act 1985) that:

(i) no civil proceedings shall without the leave of the High Court be instituted by the above-named Respondents in any Court and

(ii) that any civil proceedings instituted by the said Respondents in any Court before the making of the Order shall not be continued by the said Respondents without the leave of the High Court and

(iii) that no application (other than an application for leave under section 42 of the said Act) shall without leave of the High Court be made by the said Respondents in any civil proceedings instituted in any Court whether by or another on the ground that the said Respondents have habitually and persistently and without any reasonable ground instituted vexatious civil proceedings in the High Court and/or made vexatious applications in civil proceedings in the High Court.

And upon reading the affidavit of Matthew Phillip Gold sworn 21st September 1990, and Laurana Phillip O'Dea sworn 10th

December 1992, together with the exhibits thereto filed on behalf of the Applicant Her Majesty's Attorney General in support of these proceedings.

And upon hearing Mr. I. Burnett of Counsel on behalf of the Applicant and the Respondent Mr. Arthur Robinson in person. And the Court making no Order as to costs.

It is ordered that the Applicant's application herein be granted and that the said Repondents Arthur Robinson and Frieda Alberta Robinson be and are hereby prohibited from:

1. instituting any civil proceedings in any Court and

continuing any civil proceedings instituted by him in any Court before the making of this Order and

3. make any application other than an application for leave as required by section 42 of the said Act in any civil proceedings instituted in any Court by any person unless obtains the leave of the High Court having satisfied the High Court that the proceedings or application are not an abuse of the process of the Court in question and that there are reasonable grounds for the proceedings or application.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-up of Highways (Oldford Estate, Welshpool, Powys)

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to authorise the stopping-up of the highways discribed in the Schedule to this Notice to enable the development of a housing estate, for which planning permission has been granted, to be carried out.

The Order requires the provision of new roads, which will incorporate major parts of the highways to be stopped up, and which will be highways maintainable at public expense, for which Powys County Council shall be the Highway Authority

County Council shall be the Highway Authority.
