(All distances are approximate)

The highways to be stopped up are at the Oldford Estate, Welshpool, in the county of Powys. They are shown by zebra hatching on the first deposited plan and comprise:

1. that length of highway known as Queen's Drive, which extends from its junction with Prince of Wales Drive in a general north-easterly direction for a distance of 124 metres to a point 52 metres west of its junction with Leighton View.
2. that length of highway known as Queen's Drive, which extends from a point 51 metres south-east of its junction with Oldford Rise in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 41 metres.
3. that length of highway known as Queen's Drive, which extends from a point 27 metres west of its junction with Leighton View in a general south-easterly direction for a distance of 128 metres.
4. that length of highway known as Queen's Drive, which extends from a point 147 metres south-east of its junction with Leighton View in a general southerly direction for a distance of 126 metres to its termination point.
