WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Cumbria County Council (Hagg End) Limestone Pavement Order 1992

Notice is hereby given that on 13th January 1993, the Secretary of State for the Environment, acting under the provisions of section 34(2) and paragraphs 3(1) and 6(2) of Schedule II to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, having considered the unopposed Cumbria County Council (Hagg End) Limestone Pavement Order 1992, which took effect when it was made on 16th April 1992, decided to take no action on the Order. This means that the Order continues in force.

The Order designates the lands described in the Schedule to the Order in accordance with section 34(2) of the Act and prohibits the removal or disturbance of limestone on or in that land.

Copies of the Order and map referred to in it and of this notice have been deposited at the offices of the Cumbria County Council, County Solicitor's Department, The Courts, Carlisle, Cumbria CA3 8LZ, and may be seen, free of charge, at all reasonable hours.

Any person who is aggrieved by the Order and desires to question its validity on the grounds that it is not within the powers of section 34 of the said Act of 1981, or that any of the requirements of Schedule 11 of that Act had not been complied with in relation to it,
