#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1980

##### *Proposed Stopping-up of a Length of Mill Road, Devizes*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of a length of Mill Road and two unnamed footpaths at Devizes, Wiltshire.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out.

The proposed Order will provide that the stopping-up must not be carried out until Linpac Group Limited have provided new highway and new and improved footpaths all maintainable at the public expense for which the Highway Authority is to be the County of Wiltshire.
