ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A19 Trunk Road (New Street, Selby) (Box Junction) Order 1976 Revocation Order 1993

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on 28th May 1993, he made an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order which comes into operation on 1st June 1993, is to revoke the Trunk Road (New Street, Selby) (Box Junction) Order 1976. This will enable the current box junction on New Selby Street, Selby, at its junction with Ousegate, to be removed.
