(vi) Furzehill Road (south-west side) from a point 63 metres south-east of its junction with Shenley Road for a distance of 134 metres in a south-easterly direction;

(vii) Furzehill Road (north-east side) from a point 136 metres south-east of its junction with Shenley Road for a distance of 61 metres in a south-easterly direction.

  - (e) George Roche Road—both sides from Nunnery Fields 14 metres.
  - (f) Gordon Road—for 14 metres each side of both junctions with Henry Court.
  - (g) Henry Court— (both arms)—both sides for 5 metres from Gordon Road.
  - (h) Lincoln Avenue—both sides for 14 metres from Rochester Avenue.

  - (t) Wells Avenue—both sides from Rochester Avenue for 14 metres.
- imposing daytime (8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m., Monday to Saturday), prohibitions of waiting on:
  - (a) Puckle Lane—north-west side (i) from opposite the south-west kerb-line of Stuart Court to 8 metres south-west of Prospect Place and (ii) between points 8 and 23 metres north-east of Prospect Place and (iii) between 47 metres north-east of Prospect Place and a point opposite the boundary of Nos. 7-9 Puckle Lane.
  - (b) Randolph Close—on the north side from 14 metres north-east of Old Dover Road to the western extremity and through the turning head.
  - (c) Rochester Avenue—on the north-west side between 18 metres north-east of New Dover Road and 14 metres south of Lincoln Avenue and on the south-east side between points 42 and 87 metres noth-east of New Dover Road.
