Notice is hereby given in accordance with Schedule 10 of the above Act that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority by Severn-Trent Water Limited for consent to discharge storm sewage with trade effluent present, for flows in excess of 120 litres per second under storm conditions only to a tributary of the Sow Brook at National Grid Reference SP 4855 7523 from a storm sewage overflow situated at the rear of the printing works in Somers Road, Rugby. The storm overflow is required to alleviate flooding to two industrial units which without the overflow are flooded on average twice per year.

Notice of application for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of an inland water by means of impounding works and to abstract water.

Introduction of Taxi Parking Places in Ropemaker Street

Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of London, on 16th July 1993, made the City of London (Parking Places) (Taxis) Order 1993, under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985, so as to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the City of London (Parking Places) (Taxis) Experimental Order 1992.

The effect of the Order will be to convert coach parking places in Ropemaker Street, designated by the City of London (Coach Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1989, into parking places to be used by taxis only. The parking places will operate between 8.30 a.m. and
