

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The A4 Trunk Road (Bath Road, Keynsham) (De-restriction)  
Order 199*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 82(2) and 83(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to de-restrict that length of the London-Bristol Trunk Road (A4) (Bath Road) at Keynsham in the county of Avon, between the eastern side of its roundabout junction with the Avon Ring Road State IVA and a point 244 metres east of that roundabout, a distance of 244 metres, which is restricted by virtue of street lighting erected along that length of trunk road.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposals and a statement explaining the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected during office hours at the offices of Avon County Council, Avon House, The Haymarket, Bristol BS99 7DG; Wansdyke District Council, The Hollies, Midsomer Norton, Bath BA3 2DP, and Keynsham Library, The Centre, Keynsham, Bristol BS18 1ED.

## ANIMAL HEALTH ACT 1981

*Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980  
(as amended)*

Notice is hereby given that, as provided by Article 4 of the Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980 (as amended), the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and Welsh Office Agriculture Department have, with effect from 7th October 1993, issued the following amendment, as detailed below:

*General Import Licence Amendment Notice*

In respect of licence No. TAY/GEN/93/155 Fresh meat glands, organs and other offal (including intestinal mucosae) (not intended for human consumption) derived from ruminating animals, swine, domestic solipeds and poultry.

Amendment: Portugal should be removed from the Countries of Origin.
