make fuch Proclamation as aforefaid, fhall be adjudged Felony without benefit of Clergy, and the Offenders therein fhall be adjudged Felons, and fhall fuffer Death as in Cafe of Felony without benefit of  $\text{Cler}_{6y}$ ; and that a fo every fuch lerion and Perfons fo being unlawfully, riotoully and tumultuoufly affembled to the Number of Twelve as aforefaid, or more, to whom Pr clamation fhould or ought to have been made, if the fame had not been hindred as aforefaid, fhall likewife, in cafe they, or any of them, to the Number of Twelve, or more, fhall continue together, and not differ fe themfelves within one Hour after fuch Let or Hindrance fo made, having Knowledge of fuch Let or Hindrance fo made, ihall be adjudged Felons, and fhall fuffer Death as in Cafe of Felony without benefit of Clergy.

And be it further enacted by the Authority a-forefaid, That if after the faid last Day of July 1715, any fuch Church or Chappel, or any fuch Building for Religious Worship, or any such Dwelling house, Barn, Stable, or other Out-house shall be demolised or pulled down wholly, or in part, by any Persons so unlawfully, riotously and tu multuoufly affembled, that then in cafe fuch Church, Chappel, Building for Religious Worship, Dwelling-house, Barn, Stable, or Out-house shall be out of any City or Town that is either a County of itself, or is not within any Hundred, that then the Inhabitants of the Hundred in which fuch Damage shall be done, shall be liable to yield Damages to the Perfon or Perfons injured and damnified by fuch demolifying or pull ng down wholly or in part; and fuch Damages shall and m y be recovered by Action, to be brought in any of his Majesty's Courts of Rec rd at Westminster (wherein no Effoigne, Protection or Wager of Law, or any Imparlance shall be allowed) by the Person or Persons damnified thereby, against any two or more of the Inhabitants of fuch Hundred. Such Aftion for Damages to any Church or Chappel to be brought in the Name of the Rector, Vicar or Curate of fuch Church or Chappel that shall be so damnified, in Truft, for applying the Damages to be recover d in rebuilding or repairing fuch Church or Chappel; and that Judgment being given for the Plaintiff or Plaintiffs in fuch Action, the Damages fo to be recovered shall at the Request of such Plaintiff or Plantiffs, his or their Executors or Administrators, be raifed and levied on the Inhabitants of fuch Hundred, and paid to fuch Plaintiff or Plaintiffs in fuch manner and form, and by fuch ways and means as are provided by the Statute made in the 27th Year of the Reign of Queen *Elizabeth*, for reimburling the Perfon or Perfons on whom any Mony recovered against any Hundred by any Party robbed shall be levied; and in case any such Church, Chappel, Building for Religious Worship, Dwelling-house, Barn, Stable, or Out house so damnified shall be in any City, or Town, that is either a County of it felf, or is not within any Hundred, that then fuch Damages shall and may be recovered by Action to be brought in manner aforesaid (wherein no Essoigne, Protection or Wagerof L aw, or any Imparlance fliall be allowed) against two or more Inhabitants of fuch City or | Words.

Town, and Judgment being given for the Plaintiff or Plaintiffs in fuch Action, the Damages to to be recovered, fhall at the requeft of fuch Plaintiff or Plaintiffs, his or their Executors or Adminifirators, made to the Juffices of the Peace of fuch City or Town at any Quarter Seffions to be holden for the faid City or Town, be raifed and levied on the Inhabitants of fuch City or Town, and paid to fuch Plaintiff or Plaintiffs in fuch manner and form, and by fuch ways and means as are provided by the faid Statute made in the 27th Year of the Reign of Queen *Elizabetb* for reimburfing the Perfon or Perfons on whom any Mony recovered againft any Hundred by any Party robbed, fhall be levied.

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That this Act fiall be openly read at every Quarter Seffions, and at every Leet or Law Day. Provided always, that no Perfon or Perfons shall be prefented by vertue of this Act for any Offence or Offences committed contrary to the same, unless such Profecution be commenced within twelve Months after the Offence committed.

And he it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That the Sheriffs and their Deputies, Steuarts and their Deputies, Baillies of Regalities and their Deputies, Magisfrates of Royal Bur-roughs, and all other i re Judges and Magistrates; and also all H gh or Petty Con ables, or other Peace Officers of any County, Steuartry, City or Town within that part of Great Britain called Scotland, shall have the fame bowers and Authorit es fer putting this present Act in Execution within Scotland, as the Justices of the Feace, and other Magistrates aforefaid, respectively have by vertue of this Act within and for the other Parts of this Kingdom; and that all and every Perfon and Perfons, who shall at any time be convicted of any of the Offences aforementioned, within that Part of Great Britain called Scotland shall, for every such Offence, incur and suffer the Pain of Death and Confifcation of Moveables. And also that all Profecutions for repairing the Damages of any Church or Chappel, or any Building for Religious Worship, or any Dwelling-House, Barn, Stable or Out House, which stall be demolished or pulled down, in Whole or in Part, within Scotland, by any Perfons Unlawfully, Riotoufly or Tumultuoufly affembled, shall and may be recovered by Summary Action at the Instance of the Party aggrieved, his or her Heirs, or Executors, against the County, Stewartry, City or Borough respectively where such Disorders shall happen, the Magistrates being summoned in the ordinary Form, and the feveral Coun ies and Stewartries called by Edictal Citation at the Market Cross of the head Borough of such County or Stewartry respectively, and that in general without mentioning their Names and Delignations. Provided, and it is hereby declared, that this Act shall extend to all Places for Religious Worship in that Part of Great Britain called Scotland, which are tolerated by Law, and where His Maj-fly King George, the Prince and Prince is of Wales and their lifue, are prayed for in express
