CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cambridgeshire (High Street and Dodford Lane, Girton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1993

Notice is hereby given that on 1st November 1993, the Cambridgeshire County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which is to prohibit waiting at any time in the vicinity of the junctions of High Street and Dodford Lane, Girton.

The standard exemptions covering loading and unloading, boarding and alighting, emergency service vehicles and disabled persons vehicles will apply.
