NEW ROAD AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991 SECTION 58
(ENGLAND AND WALES)

Notice of Substantial Road Works (England and Wales)

Three month's advance notice is hereby given that South Glamorgan County Council (Highway Authority) intends to carry out substantial road works. Junction improvement on B4487 Newport Road, St. Mellons, Cardiff.

2. The street/road in which these works will take place is Newport Road/Wern Fawr Lane junction, St. Mellons, Cardiff.

3. Work is expected to affect the carriageway/footway/footpath/verge between 70 metres north-east, 30 metres north-west and 25 metres south-west of the junction.

4. Work is expected to commence on 15th March 1994.

5. The works notified will include the following:

Junction improvement/reconstruction, including vehicular and pedestrian traffic lights installation within the area described above.

6. Subject to the exemptions in the Act and Regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 5, without the consent of the said Highway Authority, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

PLANNING (LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS)
ACT 1990

Rowarth Conservation Area

Notice is hereby given under section 69 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 that the Peak Park Joint Planning Board has determined that the area described in the Schedule hereto is an area of special architectural or historic interest the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance and has accordingly designated this area as a Conservation Area.

The effect of the designation of the conservation area is as follows:

- (1) Conservation Area consent will now be required for the demolition of all unlisted buildings (other than excepted buildings) within the Conservation Area;
- (2) Planning applications for development which would in the opinion of the local planning authority affect the character or appearance of the Conservation Area must be given publicity and representations received as a result of the publicity must be taken into account in determining the application.
- (3) It becomes an offence subject to certain exceptions to cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage or wilfully destroy any tree within the Conservation Area except with the consent of the local planning authority;
- (4) The local planning authority are now under a duty formulate and publish proposals for the preservation and enhancement of the Conservation Area.
