NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—SEVERN-TRENT REGION

Notice of application for consent for the purposes of section 88

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Schedule 10 of the above Act that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority by Redland Plc for consent to discharge up to 7,500 cubic metres per day of trade effluent consisting of pumped quarry water to a tributary of the Blackmire Drain at National Grid Reference SK81766307 from Besthorpe Quarry, Besthorpe, near Newark-on-Trent.

There is an existing consent for a discharge at this site with a consented volume of 3,700 cubic metres per day, which will be superseded by the current proposal if consent is granted.

The Avon County Council (A37—Bristol to Yeovil Road at Pensford, District of Wansdyke) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1993
