TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-Up of Highways (County of West Yorkshire) (Kirklees No. 1) Order 1994" authorising the stopping-up of a length of William Street, Huddersfield and requiring the improvement of Back Union Street by widening and reconstruction.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 18th January 1994, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

The A564 Trunk Road, Stoke-derby Route (Doveridge Bypass) Compulsory Purchase Order (Em No. 4) 1993

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above mentioned Acts on 22nd December 1993 made a Compulsory Purchase Order, entitled as above.

2. The Order as made provides for the purchase of the land and rights described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of:

- (a) the construction of the new trunk roads at Uttoxeter, Doveridge and Sudbury in the Parishes of Uttoxeter, Doveridge, Somersal Herbert and Sudbury in the Districts of East Staffordshire and Derbyshire Dales in the Counties of Staffordshire and Derbyshire in pursuance of the A564 Trunk Road, Stoke-derby Route (Doveridge Bypass and Slip Roads) Order 1993;

(b) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in the said Districts and Counties in pursuance of the A564 Trunk Road, Stoke-derby Route (Doveridge Bypass) (Side Roads) Order 1993;

(c) the improvement of the A50 Trunk Road in the said Parishes, Districts and Counties;

(d) the diversion of watercourses and the execution of other works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk roads, the construction and improvement of the other highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;

(e) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above; and

(f) mitigating any adverse effect which the existence or use of certain of the highways proposed to be constructed or improved by him as mentioned above will have on the surroundings thereof.

3. The land described at plot numbered 3-30, in the Schedule hereto forms part of an open space and the Secretary of State for the Environment has certified in accordance with section 19(1)(b) of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 that he is satisfied that the said land does not exceed 250 square yards in extent and that the giving in exchange of other land is unnecessary, whether in the interests of the persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights or in the interests of the public.

4. Copies of the Order as made by the Secretary of State and of the plan referred to therein, together with copies of the above mentioned Trunk Road Order and Side Roads Order (each with its accompanying plans), have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours from 11th January 1994 to 22nd February 1994 at the Department of Transport, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB; and at the offices of the Director of Network Management and Construction, East Midlands Region, Cranbrook House, Cranbrook Street, Nottingham NG1 1EY; the Derbyshire County Council, County Offices, Matlock, Derbyshire DE4 3AG; the Derbyshire Dales District Council, Town Hall, Bank Road, Matlock, Derbyshire DE4 3NN; the Staffordshire County Council, Martin Street, Staffordshire ST16 2LH; the East Staffordshire Borough Council, Town Hall, Burton-upon-Trent, Staffordshire DE14 2EB and the Uttoxeter Library, Red Gables, High Street, Uttoxeter, Staffordshire ST14 7JQ.

5. The Order as made comes into force on the date on which this notice is first published, but a person aggrieved by the Order may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks from that date, question its validity on the grounds:

- (i) that the authorisation granted by the Order is not empowered to be granted, or
