During the period of the Order, all westbound traffic wishing to enter the C258 should continue to the A47/A1042 Interchange at Postwick before turning. Traffic normally turning right onto the trunk road from C258 should turn left on the A47 and turn at the A47/C429 Cucumber Lane Roundabout at Brundall.

The provisions of the Order will not apply to agricultural vehicles.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 28th February 1994, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or of any provision contained therein.
