

SCHEDULE

Proposed Prohibition of Driving Order

To be imposed on the two existing gaps in the central reservation of Fabian Way (A483) at the following location:

- (a) Directly opposite the Vale of Neath Road junction and
- (b) Directly opposite the Alcan Works entrance located on the south side of Fabian Way.

The closure of the gaps is considered necessary as they are the subject of continual traffic conflicts and accidents associated with vehicles utilising them to execute various right hand and 'U' turn manoeuvres. The gaps in the central reservation are of insufficient width to harbour vehicles (especially the larger type) in safety without the vehicles front or rear end encroaching into the offside lanes of Fabian Way.

Alternative Route

Westbound Vehicles can utilise the recently installed traffic signal installation and mini roudabout (associated with the new Alcan access) to retrace their route involving an additional maximum distance of 0.38 miles.

Eastbound Vehicles can utilise the road network at Baldwins Interchange to retrace their route involving an additional maximum distance of 2.15 miles.

Any objections to the proposals should be submitted in writing setting out the reasons thereof to reach the Director of Environment & Highways, County Hall, Swansea, by 4th March 1994.

Gloucestershire County Council Road Hump Scheme (Little Australia), Stonehouse
