Leeds City Council (Traffic Regulation) (No. 32) Order 1993, Prohibition of Waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Limewood Approach, Seacroft, Leeds 14.

Notice is hereby given that the Leeds City Council has made an Order dated 18th February 1994, under the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order, which comes into operation on 28th February 1993, is to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive in lengths of Limewood Approach, Seacroft, Leeds 14.
