PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

Notice of the Issue of a Submarine Pipe-line Works Authorisation

The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to be held by Amerada Hess Limited, whose address is 33 Grosvenor Place, London SW1X 7HY, for the construction of two 10 inch flow-lines; three 8 inch flow-lines; four 6 inch jumber lines; one 8 inch water injection pipe-line; one 6 inch gas lift line and one chemical injection pipe-line between the Tern Platform and the Hudson Field.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the 10 inch, 8 inch and 6 inch flow-lines and jumper pipe-lines shall only be used to convey crude oil and associated liquids, the 8 inch water injection pipe-line shall only be used to convey water, the 6 inch life pipe-line shall only be used to convey lift gas and the chemical injection pipe-line shall only be used to convey corrosion inhibitor, scale inhibitor, demulsifier, wax inhibitor and methanol.

The pipe-lines may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

Amerada Hess Limited and Shell U.K. Exploration and Production have been appointed operators of separate aspects of pipeline operations.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-up of Highways (Angelina Street, Butetown, Cardiff, South Glamorgan) Order 1994

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to authorise the stopping-up of the highway described in the Schedule to this notice to enable a residential extension, for which planning permission has been granted, to be carried out.

Copies of the made Order and relevant plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of South Glamorgan County Council, County Highways Department, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, during a period of 6 weeks from 22nd March 1994.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990; or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act.

he may within 6 weeks of 22nd March 1994 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provisions contained therein.

SCHEDULE

(all distances are approximate)

The area of highway to be stopped-up is at Butetown, Cardiff, in the county of South Glamorgan. It is shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan and is a rectangular area of footway which extends from the north-western corner of the property known as 58 Angelina Street, for a distance of 1.6 metres in a south-westerly direction and 0.7 metres in a general southward direction.
