The application, Ref. O48/21A/2993, is to discharge a maximum

of 2,525 cubic metres per day of treated sewage into Mounts Bay, off the entrance of Porthleven Harbour at NGR SW 6268 2545.

The proposal will involve removal of existing unsatisfactory crude sewage discharges and provision of a high level of sewage treatment. Significant improvements in bathing water quality are anticipated, as this proposal represents a significant improvement to the existing inadequate drainage arrangements.
