

(c) the restrictions on waiting which now apply between 10 a.m. and 12 noon on Mondays to Fridays in part of Three Corners will be revoked.

The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2(a), (b) and (c) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g. the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" would apply.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 27th June 1994, of the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1991 (and of the Orders which have amended that Order), a map which indicates the length of road to which the Order relates and the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until 6 weeks from the date on which this Notice is published at (a) The Information Centre, London Borough of Bexley, Bexley Civic Offices, Broadway, Bexleyheath, Kent DA6 7LB and (b) Reception, London Borough of Bexley, Sidcup Place, Sidcup, Kent DA14 6BT.

4. Copies of the Order may be purchased from the Chief Engineer's Department, London Borough of Bexley, Room 20, Sidcup Place, Sidcup, Kent DA14 6BT.

5. Any persons desiring to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made make application for the purpose to the High Court.

London Borough of Bexley Amendments to Controlled Parking Zone Bexleyheath Area

Bexley Council has made a large number of changes to on-street parking arrangements in Bexleyheath as detailed below. If you need any further information please ring Mr. Pathy on 081 303 7777, Ext. 3617.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Bexley on 20th June 1994, made the following Traffic Orders:

- (a) The Bexley (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1994 under sections 6, 45, 46 and 49 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended;
- (b) The Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 18) under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the above-mentioned Act of 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Orders which will come into operation on 1st July 1994, will be to amend the system of controlled parking in the Bexleyheath Area in the London Borough of Bexley in the streets and parts of streets listed in Schedule I to this notice (hereinafter referred to as the "Controlled Zone") and impose further restrictions upon waiting by vehicles.

3. The Bexley (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1994 will revoke the Bexley (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1987 and:

- (i) designate parking places on the highways specified in Schedules 2, 3, 4 and 5 at which charges will be made by the Council for the leaving of vehicles authorised by the Order and designate parking places on the highways specified in Schedule 6 at which no charge will be made.
- (ii) provide that the parking places on the highways in Schedules 2, 3, 4 and 5 will be in operation between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (except on Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays), and that the parking places on the highway in Schedule 6 will be in operation between the hours of 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive (except on Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays);
- (iii) specify that, in respect of Schedule 2 and 3 parking places, and the parking places in Methuen Road, Oaklands Road, Tower Road and Woolwich Road which are "shared" between visitors and residents passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles and invalid carriages may be left therein, and in respect of the parking places in Methuen Road,

Oaklands Road, Tower Road and Woolwich Road, vehicles displaying a valid residents' permit in a protective cover issued by the Council or a valid visitors' permit may be left therein;

- (iv) specify that, in respect of Schedule 4 parking places, vehicles displaying a valid residents' permit in a protective cover issued by the Council or a valid visitors' permit may be left therein and in respect of Schedule 5 parking places vehicles displaying a valid residents' permit in a protective cover issued by the Council or a valid visitors' permit may be left therein;
- (v) specify that, in respect of Schedule 6 parking places passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), a goods carrying vehicle not more than 2.25 metres in height, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage may be left therein, without any charges;
- (vi) provide that residents' permits and protective covers or visitors' permits will be issued by the Council on application being made by any person residing in the streets and parts of streets listed in Schedule 1 who is the owner of a passenger vehicle (12 seats or less), a goods carrying vehicle not more than 2.25 metres in height, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage;
- (vii) provide that business permits and protective covers will be issued by the Council on application being made by any person who occupies premises the postal address of which is in any street or part of a street listed in Schedule 1 and who uses such premises for non-residential purposes and who is the owner of a passenger vehicle (12 seats or less), a goods-carrying vehicle of not more than 2.25 metres in height, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage;
- (viii) Specify that:

(a) in the Schedule 2 parking places and the parking places in Methuen Road, Oaklands Road, and Tower Road Road, the initial charge will be at the rate of 20 pence for a period of 30 minutes; maximum 2 hours;

(b) in the Schedule 3 parking places and the parking places in Woolwich Road, the initial charge would be at the rate of 10 pence for a period of one hour, maximum nine hours;

(c) the charge for residents' permits will be £6 or £20 for permits expiring at the end of 3 months and 12 months respectively running from the beginning of the month in which they were issued. The charge for visitors' permit (valid for one half of a day) will be 25 pence (for use in Schedule 4 and 5 parking places on the "shared bays"). The charge for a business permit will be £35 or £120 for permits expiring at the end of 3 months and 12 months respectively running from the beginning of the month in which they were issued. (The permits will have to be displayed so that all the particulars on it were readily visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle).

- (ix) specify that the penalty charge for parking in Schedule 2 or 3 parking places or the parking places in Methuen Road, Oaklands Road, Tower Road or Woolwich Road, either without paying the initial charge or for parking for a period longer than the period for which initial charge was paid or for parking in Schedule 4 or 5 parking places without displaying a valid permit will be payable, and that the unexpired time shown on the parking meter may be used free of charge, and the period during which a vehicle may not be returned to a parking place will be one hour; and
- (x) provide that certain vehicles could wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles left by specified disabled persons (no time limit).

4. The Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 18) 1994, will further amend the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1991 (as amended) so that:

- (a) (i) the existing restrictions on waiting by vehicles in parts of Broadway, Arnsberg Way and Highland Road which apply between 8 a.m. and Midnight, Mondays to Saturdays inclusive will be amended so that the restrictions apply between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays.
- (ii) restrictions on waiting by vehicles (other than in designated parking places) between the hours 8.30 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive will apply in parts of Brookfield Road, Highfield Road, Nursery Avenue, Oaklands Road, Pinnacle Hill, Rowan Road, Stonefield Close, Townley Road, Watling Street and Woolwich Road.
- (iii) restrictions on waiting by vehicles (other than in designated parking places) between the hours 2 p.m. and 3 p.m., Mondays to Fridays will apply in parts of Chieveley Road, Dorothy Evans Close, Martens Avenue, Martens Close, Pinnacle Hill North, Sevenoaks Close, Springfield Road and Spring Vale.
