The A466 Trunk Road (Wye Valley Link Road, Chepstow, Gwent) (De-Restriction) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 82 and 83 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
