The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (Bryn Road, Lampeter, Dyfed) Order 199

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes, on the application of the Ceredigion District Council, to make an Order under section 249 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 extinguishing, subject to certain exceptions, any rights which persons may have to use vehicles on the length of highway described in the Schedule to this notice.

During 28 days from 3rd August 1994 copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Ceredigion District Council, Local Office, Town Hall, Lampeter, or may be obtained, free of charge, from the address shown below.

Within the above mentioned period of 28 days any person may by notice to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL (quoting ref. ZC 510-5-2-24), object to the making of the Order. In the preparation of an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

SCHEDULE

The highway is situated at Lampeter in the county of Dyfed and is that length of Bryn Road which extends from its junction with Church Street for a distance of approximately 95 metres in a westerly direction to its junction with Temple Terrace. (487)

DISEASES OF FISH ACT 1937

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food having reasonable grounds for suspecting that certain inland waters and land adjacent to them are infected areas, has made the Diseases of Fish (Designated Areas) (England) (No. 16) Order 1994.

The Order designates that area for the purpose of section 2 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937, and restricts the movement of live fish and eggs of fish without the previous consent, in writing, of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food.

The Order came into force on 30th July 1994.
