## DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

#### *Stopping-up of Highway at Widnes*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Halton Borough Council and following the holding of a Public Local Inquiry he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (Borough of Halton) (No. 1) Order 1994" authorising the stopping-up of Moon Street and lengths of various other highways and unnamed passageways in the vicinity of Moon Street at Widnes.

## HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

### *The M27 South Coast Motorway (Ower-Chilworth Section) Connecting Roads Scheme 1970 (Variation) Scheme 1994*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made a Scheme under sections 16, 17, 19 and 326(7) and (8) of the Highways Act 1980, entitled The M27 South Coast Motorway (Ower-Chilworth Section) Connecting Roads Scheme 1970 (Variation) Scheme 1994 providing that The M27 South Coast Motorway (Ower-Chilworth Section) Connecting Roads Scheme 1970 be varied.

The Variation Scheme will vary the provisions of The M27 South Coast Motorway (Ower-Chilworth Section) Connecting Roads Scheme 1970 by deletion of the length of special road that connects the A36 trunk road with Junction 2 of the M27 Motorway at Ower in the County of Hampshire. That length of special road will continue to be a trunk road.

Any person aggrieved by the Variation Scheme who desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provision in it, on the ground that:

- it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or
- any requirement of that Act or of regulations made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Variation Scheme.

may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice. On such an application, the Court may suspend or quash the Variation Scheme or any provision in it.
