WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY ACT 1949

Notice of Variation of Citizens' Band Radio Licence

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice, pursuant to subsection 1(4) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949 to holders of the Citizens' Band Radio Licence ("the Licence") that, from 9th September 1994, each licence shall be varied as follows:

In this notice "the Booklet" means the Terms, Provisions and Limitations Booklet, The terms of which form part of the licence.

As and from the date hereof the licence shall be read and construed as if:

(1) sub-clause 4(1) of the booklet were deleted and replaced by "If a CB station is formed of 26-27 MHz apparatus with provision for connection to an external antenna then such apparatus shall only be connected to one of the following types of antennas:

(a) a single vertical omnidirectional monopole antenna, the driven element of which does not exceed 6.95 metres in length or 55 millimetres in diameter, including any loading coils and associated circuitry and casings, but excluding any plates, radial wires or rods designed solely to act as a ground plane or counterpoise, which are located at the physical base of the antenna;

(b) a single vertical omnidirectional dipole antenna not exceeding 5.55 metres in length.

The use of loop, yagi or any type of beam antenna is prohibited"; and

(2) in Note 8 to the Licence in the Booklet the list of CEPT member countries and the abbreviations by which they are identified (where known) were deleted and replaced by the following:
