

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that:

- it is not within the powers contained in the above Act; or
- any requirement of the above Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with,

may apply to the High Court before 10th November 1994, to suspend or reject the Order or any part of it.
